Single-use plastics are on their way out

The Alameda Disposable Food Service Ware Reduction Law was created to reduce the number of single-use plastics generated within the City of Alameda.

Beginning July 1, 2018, Alameda businesses must provide:

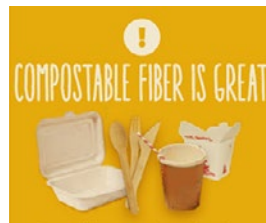
- straws on request
- fiber-based compostable disposables (*paper, wood, bamboo, etc.*)
- reusable dishware where possible

By finding ways to reduce to-go packaging, Alamedans are ensuring fewer straws and other single-use disposable items become litter on our beaches and streets, decreasing pollution in the Bay and are reducing the amount of waste going to the landfill. More information at: AlamedaRecycles.org.
