In efforts to adhere to local and state (AB 1826) laws for organics collection, the Alameda County Waste Management Authority (ACWMA) may issue violations to businesses with food permits and 4 or more cubic yards of total service per week (garbage + recycling) that do not have organics service in place.

- For businesses that do not meet the above criteria and do not generate a significant amount of organics (less than 20 gallons per week), organics service is not required at this time.
- Regardless of food permits or service level, if a significant amount of organics is found in the garbage during routine inspections, businesses will receive violation(s) and be required to have organics service.
