CHOOSE REUSABLES. Make it a habit to use travel mugs, reusable water bottles and shopping bags/totes. **BONUS POINTS!** Bring reusable containers with you for leftovers or to-go orders at your favorite restaurant!

BEFORE YOU REPLACE AN ITEM, SEE IF IT CAN BE REPAIRED. If you do purchase something new, find the highest quality/longest lasting option possible.

OPT FOR USED PRODUCTS. Reuse what you already have or purchase a “gently used” item from a resale/thrift shop. Browse reuse websites (see other side) or share/trade items with friends and neighbors.

ACI's On-Call Clean Up Program

Once every 12 months, residents of single-family and multi-plex buildings (with 4 or fewer units) can schedule a free clean up that includes:

- Up to 2 cubic yards of unwanted household items.
- Properly contained latex paint.
- Household batteries.
- Up to 3 bulky items.
