

Alameda County Mandatory Recycling Ordinance (MRO)

**NEW REQUIREMENTS
ARE EFFECTIVE
JANUARY 1, 2021**

ARE YOU COMPLIANT?

State and local mandatory recycling laws require customers with **2 or more cubic yards** of service per week (garbage + recycling) to obtain organics collection service.

- Businesses that generate less than 20 gallons of organics per week may be exempt.
- Businesses are subject to periodic inspection and will receive violations if they do not have organics service and/or a significant amount of organics is found in garbage or recycling bins.
