# New California Compost & Recycling Law for Businesses and Multifamily Properties\*

## **EFFECTIVE JANUARY 2022**

When compostable materials like food scraps, paper, and plant trimmings break down in landfills, they produce methane, a potent greenhouse gas and contributor to climate change.

New California state law (SB 1383) will help keep compostable materials out of landfills. A local ordinance will be put in place to help resdents and businesses comply with the regulations set by the state.



Placing food scraps in the compost bin instead of the garbage helps fight



The local law will be implemented through a partnership between the City of Alameda, Alameda County Industries, StopWaste, and Alameda County Environmental Health Departments.

# SENATE BILL 1383

### What Does This New Law Mean for my Business or Multifamily Property?

- All sites must have compost and recycling collection service.
  Contact ACI to start or improve your recycling and composting!
- Compost and recycling bins must be placed next to all garbage bins, including indoors, except in restrooms. Items must also be properly sorted into the bins.
- Free help and indoor green bins are available.
- Large businesses that generate surplus edible food—such as grocery stores, food distributors, and large restaurants must donate food to food recovery organizations.

## Real Holiday Trees are a Renewable Resource!

- Real holiday trees grown on farms emit oxygen that absorbs carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases that contribute to global warming.
- Tree farms also: help stabilize the soil, protect water supplies & can provide refuge for wildlife.
- Real clean green holiday trees are 100% compostable.

HOLIDAY TREE COLLECTION: We will collect holiday trees from our Commercial customers for a fee. Multi-Family customers: check with your building manager for a designated tree drop-off area, trees are typically collected curbside for small complexes.

#### CLEAN GREEN TREES WILL BE COMPOSTED. REMEMBER:

- All lights, decorations, and tree stands must be removed.
- Trees should be put out loose. Do not wrap or bag them.
- Trees over 6-feet tall must be cut in half.
- Small trees can be placed inside your **Organics** cart or bin. Please cut into pieces that will not get stuck or prevent the lid from closing.
- Fake and flocked trees cannot be composted and are disposed as garbage-contact us to arrange for disposal.
