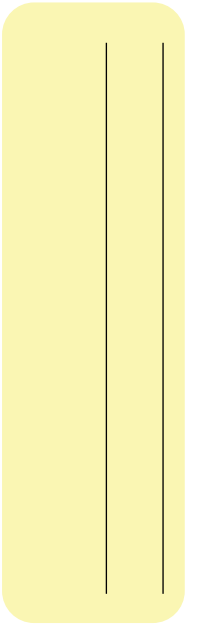

## Clean Up is in the Bag!

### 1 GET THE BAG

ACI will deliver a 2-cubic yard (4'x4'x4') bag to your residence.



### 2 PREPARE THE BAG

Open the bag in the street curbside. THE BAG MUST BE AT CURB FOR COLLECTION. (When full, it may be too heavy to move.) Make sure the straps are on the **OUTSIDE** of the bag.



### 3 FILL THE BAG

Commonly disposed of items include: books, toys, clothing, housewares, packaging materials (styrofoam blocks, large boxes), wood (not painted, stained or treated.) & yard trimmings. All items must fit within the bag and not protrude. Single items over 75 pounds are NOT allowed inside the bag.



## Out of the Bag...

**BULKY ITEMS:** Set out up to three appliances, one may be an electronic waste (e-waste) item, next to the bag. Refrigerator or freezer doors must be removed or taped shut. Computers, printers, televisions, large microwaves, and similar items are acceptable as e-waste. Place small e-waste in a discardable box or bag before setting next to the clean up bag. Extra bulky items including mattresses, furniture, exercise equipment and more can be collected for a fee.



**HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES:** Place alkaline and lithium batteries in a clear, zipper-lock style bag next to the bag but not in the gutter. Please tape terminals on all lithium, 6-volt and 9-volt alkaline batteries.



## Please Note...

**SCRAP METAL:** Items (less than 30lbs.) can be placed in your blue **recyclables** cart.



**YARD TRIMMINGS:** Grass clippings, leaves, and small branches less than 6" in diameter can go in the green **organics** cart.

## Not Allowed in the Bag...

The following items will **NOT** be collected as part of your clean up service:

- Loose materials placed outside the bag except for the bulky items noted at left. **Extra bulky items will incur a fee.**
- Any single item over 75 pounds **INSIDE** the 2-cubic yard bag.
- Wood longer than four feet.
- Automobile parts.
- Dirt, sod, treated wood, cement, rock, brick, drywall, sinks, windows and other construction and demolition materials.



## HAZARDOUS WASTE HAS ITS PLACE.

Household hazardous waste (HHW), radioactive materials, unwanted medications and sharps, poisonous or toxic materials are not accepted in any Alameda County Industries collection carts or bins. ## Remember!

- The bag must be at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled collection day.
- Set out up to three appliances and properly contained latex paint next to the bag.
- Move vehicles away from the bag for collection access.
