- Properties with on-site service must place plant debris in a designated organics collection container. Learn more at www.stopwaste.org/at-work/regulations-compliance.
- Business owners or managers can arrange for the removal of plant debris by their landscaper. **PLEASE NOTE: The landscaper must haul to an approved facility and deposit plant debris in the facility's designated "clean green" area.**
