## Expanded On-Call Clean Up Program Now Includes Multi-family Tenants

### NOW ACCEPTING:

#### Reusable Items

- Clean, undamaged reusable items only such as housewares, toys, sports equipment, non-upholstered furniture, clothing (clean & dry), accessories, textiles, framed pictures/art, craft/sewing items, books, magazines, CDs, VHS, and DVDs. #### Clean Up Items

- Up to 3 cubic yards (3' x 3' x 9') of materials (including reusable items).
- Trash that is contained (bagged, boxed, or bundled).
- Recyclables such as cardboard, scrap metal, paper, bottles, and cans that are contained (bagged, boxed, or bundled).
- Yard trimmings and clean wood up to 6 inches in diameter tied in bundles no longer than 4 feet, please bag small/loose trimmings (pressure treated wood not accepted).

#### Large Bulky Items

- Up to three (3) large bulky items such as appliances, mattresses, and furniture (up to 150 lbs. each). One item can be e-waste.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Fees will be charged for exceeding the volume or the acceptable item limits listed. Extra clean ups can be arranged for a fee. Visit our website or contact us for rates.



## California Law SB 1383 Requires Recycling & Composting



*Participating fully in an organics and recycling waste diversion program is now required for every resident and business in Alameda.*

## Household Hazardous Waste & E-Waste Program

**Hazardous waste does NOT belong in any ACI collection cart or bin.**

Before tossing it out, check the label. If it's marked Danger, Warning, Poisonous, Toxic, or Flammable, it's hazardous and requires special handling. Many hazardous items can be taken to Alameda County's local household hazardous waste collection facility. Take advantage of this free drop-off program (appointment required). **PLEASE NOTE:** Multi-Family customers with cart service can place household batteries in a zipper-style bag on top of (not inside) their blue **recyclables** cart for collection. Multi-Family customers with shared service can establish a safe contained area on or near the blue **recyclables** container for bagged batteries in their collection enclosures with their complex owner or manager.



## Keep our Workers Safe! PLEASE REMEMBER, NO SHARPS!

**"Sharps" is a medical term for devices with sharp points or edges that can puncture or cut skin such as needles, syringes, lancets, auto injectors (such as EpiPens), and infusions sets.**
