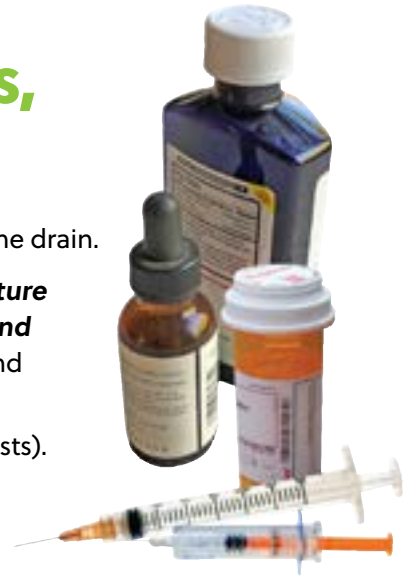

Safe Disposal of Medicines, Sharps, Household Batteries, and E-Waste

MEDICINES & SHARPS should never be put in the garbage or flushed down the drain.

- **“Sharps”** is a medical term for devices with sharp points or edges that can puncture or cut skin such as needles, syringes, lancets, auto injectors (such as EpiPens), and infusions sets. – Package in FDA approved sharps containers made with puncture and leak-resistant plastic.
- **Pills** - Pour into zipper-lock style bags (it protects your privacy and lowers disposal costs). It's ok to mix all your pills in one bag. The bag can be taken to the Alameda County Sheriff's Eden Township Substation (address below) or visit www.stopwaste.org/recycling/residents/household-hazardous-waste/medicine for more information and other drop off locations.
- **Liquids & Creams** - Leave in their original container & secure caps/lids, black out any personal identifying information and place in a zipper-lock style bag. The bag can be taken to the Alameda County Sheriff's Eden Township Substation (address below) or visit www.stopwaste.org/recycling/residents/household-hazardous-waste/medicine for more information and other drop off locations.
- **Controlled Substances** - Include: narcotic pain medications, sleeping pills, ADD/ADHD drugs, antidepressants, and cough syrups with Codeine. HHW facilities and many other drop off locations **CANNOT ACCEPT CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES**. These items can be taken to the self-service drop box in lobby at:

PLEASE NOTE: Prescription medication is no longer accepted at the Oakland, Livermore, and Hayward HHW drop-off facilities. Prescription medication is accepted at the Fremont HHW drop-off facility and at over 70 drug stores, hospitals, and law enforcement sites throughout the County. HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES - Batteries in a zipper-lock style bag may be dropped off at the ACI office. Refer to the contact page on our website for location and hours. We accept alkaline, lithium, rechargeable, camera, watch, hearing aid, and calculator batteries. Please tape the positive terminals. Car batteries are NOT accepted.



E-WASTE REQUIRES SPECIAL HANDLING - Electronic waste (E-waste) includes: televisions, computers, telephones, stereo equipment, microwave ovens, thermostats, ballasts for fluorescent lamps, digital clocks, MP3 music players, digital/video cameras, cathode ray tubes (CRTs), and devices with CRTs. You may take e-waste to an Alameda County Household Hazardous Waste Facility for drop-off. Call 800-606-6606 or visit www.Stopwaste.org/hhw for more information.
