



WHAT DOES THIS NEW LAW MEAN FOR MY MULTIFAMILY PROPERTY?

- All sites must have adequate compost and recycling collection services.
- Compost and recycling bins must be placed next to all garbage bins, including indoors, except in rest-rooms. Items must also be properly sorted into the bins.
