Take these easy steps to keep your collection costs down & collection safe & efficient.



- Properly sort your materials. Scan the QR code on your container for a full translatable list of what goes where.
- Make sure your container lids close to prevent overflow and litter.
- Bag loose trash and place in the gray garbage containers. (Remember that items such as masks, gloves, wipes, tissues, and anything with bodily fluids on it should be bagged and placed in the garbage.)
- Do not place items outside of your containers. Remember, all multi-family residential customers receive one (1) on call clean-up day per household/unit per year at no additional charge. Find more information at www.alamedacountyindustries.com/alameda/cleanup

City and State Regulations Require Recycling and Composting\*

## SERVICE REMINDER Keep an Eye on the Size

Corrugated cardboard and paper boxes should be flattened and large pieces cut to 3' x 2' or smaller. Doing so:

- allows for more room in the container
- prevents overflow and litter
- assures the pieces will fit in the hoppers of the collection vehicles
