Food Scraps & Food Soiled Paper Belong in Your Green Collection Bin

Senate Bill 1383 requires multi-family complexes to have adequate organics collection service in place*

The handy kitchen pail helps with proper sorting of organics. Tenants can use it to collect food soiled paper and food scraps in their homes and empty the contents of the pail into the outdoor green organics collection containers at your complex. SERVICE REMINDER Small Actions Make a HUGE Impact

KEEP IT CLEAN & DRY

Empty, wipe or rinse recyclable plastic, metal, and glass food containers; and make sure recyclable paper is clean and dry. Keep recyclables loose inside your collection containers.



DID YOU KNOW?

Recyclables in bags, especially opaque/black ones, are sorted out as garbage and end up in the landfill. Keep recyclables loose, **NO BAGS** are needed in the curbside recycling program.

HOLIDAY SERVICE SCHEDULE: Collection days will NOT change during the week of Labor Day.

RATE INCREASE: Effective July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 there will be a 5% increase in rates from ACI (Alameda County Industries) for the collection of Garbage, Recycling, and Organics.
