Sustainable Holiday Practices

Reduce your environmental footprint, decrease waste, and save money.

GREEN YOUR GIFT GIVING BY REDUCING, REUSING, AND RECYCLING

- Support a charity or cause by shopping for gently-used treasures at resale and thrift shops.
- Encourage waste reduction by giving reusable totes, food containers, utensils, water bottles, and travel mugs as gifts.
- Think about gifts that can help conserve energy like smart thermostats and light switches.

REDUCE HOLIDAY WASTE

- When shopping for gifts, bring your own bag.
- Use tags, cards, and wrapping paper printed on recycled paper - or even better - make your own.
- Recycle baskets, tins, or boxes when wrapping gifts or use reusable materials like newspaper, t-shirts, and reusable bags.

Try an Alternative Christmas Tree

Avoid a cut or fake plastic tree this year. Go green with a sustainable alternatives.

- Rent or adopt a tree that is delivered alive and then replanted once you are finished.
- Decorate a plant or tree you already have.
- Purchase a potted tree that you can use each year or plant after Christmas.
- Get creative! Make a tree out of books, photo collage, or wooden frames, the possibilities are endless.



Holiday Tree Collection

ACI will collect holiday trees curbside from **Dec. 26 -Jan. 31** on your service day.


REMEMBER:

- Remove all decorations, lights and the stand.
- Trees should be put out loose. Do not wrap or bag them.
- Cut your tree in half if it is taller than 6' and place curbside next to your organics container.
- Small trees can be placed inside your ORGANICS cart. Please cut your tree into pieces so it does not get stuck in the cart or prevent the lid from closing
- Flocked trees are accepted, but will not be composted.
- Artificial trees are not accepted and belong in the garbage when reuse is no longer viable. Contact us for collection options.

PLEASE NOTE: Tree collection will occur with special trucks throughout the day and at different times than your regular collection services.
