COLLECTION DAY REMINDERS **Help Us Provide** Safe & Efficient **Service**

- Place carts out for collection by 6:00am and remove prior to 12:00am the following day.
- Make sure cart wheels are facing your home.
- Leave three feet (or as much space as possible) between each cart and avoid placing carts near obstacles.
- Place materials loosely in carts so they will empty properly.
- Make sure cart lids are fully closed. Overloaded carts can cause litter and attract critters.
- Report damaged carts to ACI so that we can schedule a repair or replacement on your next service day.

The ACI On-Call Clean Up Program

All residential customers receive one (1) on call clean-up day per household per year at no additional charge. On-Call Clean ups include the collection of:

- **Reusable Items** Clean, undamaged reusable items labeled and set aside from other items.
- Clean Up Items Up to 3 cubic yards (3' x 3' x 9') of materials (including reusable items).
- Large Bulky Items Up to three (3) large bulky items such as appliances, mattresses, and furniture (up to 150 lbs. each).


