# Mandatory Organics Reduction & Recycling Ordinance (ORRO)



**ORGANICS REDUCTION & RECYCLING ORDINANCE**

***Did You Know? Complying with the ORRO is as simple as separating all plant debris from garbage and recycling.\****

- Properties must place plant debris in a designated organics collection container. Learn more at [StopWaste.org/Rules](http://StopWaste.org/Rules)
- Need Organics collection service? Contact ACI to start **ORGANICS** collection services today.
- Business owners or managers can arrange for the removal of plant debris by their landscaper. A form is required; see below.

***Does a landscaping company off-haul your yard trimmings? We want to know!***

CalRecycle now requires businesses to provide written documentation from the landscaper that the material is being hauled to a facility that composts it in order to receive AB 1826 compliance.

## A Word About Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383)

*This California State law helps to keep compostable materials out of landfills.*

All San Leandro residents and businesses are required to have adequate organic waste collection services in place to recycle organic materials such as food scraps, food-soiled paper, and yard trimmings.

Implementation of this law is through a partnership between the City of San Leandro, ACI, StopWaste, and Alameda County Environmental Health Departments.

## Rate Increase

Effective July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025, there will be a **3.19%** increase in rates from ACI (Alameda County Industries) for the collection of Garbage, Recycling, and Organics. This rate increase is consistent with the City's franchise agreement with ACI, which determines how rates are set.
