- Use perishable produce quickly.
- Track inventory to prevent over-ordering and spoilage.
- Store all food properly.
- Keep your storage equipment in good working order.
- Prepare for power loss by having a back up power plan.

FOOD DONATION IS REQUIRED

Donating surplus food is required by state and local law. Senate Bill 1383 requires certain food-generating sites to donate surplus edible food to food recovery

Avoid a Cut or Fake Plastic Tree This Year **GO GREEN WITH A SUSTAINABLE ALTERNATIVE**

Decorate a plant or tree you already have, or purchase a potted tree that you can use each year or plant after the holidays.

NO FEE HOLIDAY TREE COLLECTION:

ACI will collect holiday trees from our commercial customers at no additional charge. Commercial locations with centralized collection services can designate a collection area for trees during the

month of January. Approval of the designated collection area by ACI personnel is required. Scan the QR code for more information and contact us to make collection arrangements.

CLEAN, GREEN TREES WILL BE COMPOSTED. REMEMBER:

- Remove all decorations, lights, and the stand.
- Cut the tree in half if taller than 6 feet.
- Keep trees loose. Do not wrap or bag them.
- Flocked trees are accepted as garbage & will not be composted.
- Artificial trees are not accepted and belong in the garbage when reuse is no longer viable. Please contact ACI to arrange collection options.
- Make sure your collection enclosures and designated collection areas are not blocked and are assesible to our collection vehicles.
