



Take Advantage of the ACI On-Call Bulky Item Clean-Up Program

All residential customers receive one (1) on-call clean-up day per household per year at no additional charge. On-Call Clean-ups include the collection of:

- **Reusable Items** - Clean, undamaged reusable items labeled and set aside from other items.
- **Clean Up Items** - Up to 3 cubic yards (3' x 3' x 9') of materials, including reusable items. See photo above for set-out example.
- **Large Bulky Items** - Up to three (3) large bulky items such as appliances, mattresses, and furniture (up to 150 lbs. each).

Maintain Smoke Detectors and Carbon Monoxide Alarms



- ✓ Test existing detectors and alarms.
 - ✓ Install new batteries and properly recycle the old ones.
(See back for household battery curbside collection information.)
 - ✓ Remove non-working detectors/alarms and install new ones.
 - ✓ Dispose of non-working detectors/alarms responsibly.
- Many manufacturers offer a mail-in program for smoke detectors and CO2 alarms. Refer to the product label, user's manual, or warranty for manufacturer's instructions.

Minimize Water Pollution

Alameda County storm drains do not go to a treatment plant, instead they flow directly to creeks and the Bay. Here are ways keep our waterways clean and safe.

- Check your driveway or parking area for fluid leaks. If your car is leaking, use a drip pan and arrange repair.
- When changing your oil, contain and recycle used oil and filters properly. (Free curbside pickup available, see back!)
- Don't wash vehicles in the driveway/street. Soap and cleaning products are harmful to aquatic life.
- Prevent leaves from clogging storm drains, place them in your green **organics** cart.
- Avoid applying fertilizers and pesticides, especially if rain is in the forecast.



Help us Provide Safe & Efficient Service

- Place carts out for collection by 6:00am and remove prior to 12:00am the following day.
- Make sure cart wheels are facing your home.
- Leave three feet (or as much space as possible) between each cart and avoid placing carts near obstacles.
- Place materials loosely in carts so they will empty properly.
- Make sure cart lids are fully closed. Overloaded carts can cause litter and attract critters.
- Report damaged carts to ACI so that we can schedule a repair or replacement on your next service day.

Used Oil & Filter Collection: ACI offers **free** curbside collection of used motor oil jugs, used cooking oil in sealed screw top containers, and filter bags. Contact us via our website or call (510) 483-1400 for delivery of a free used oil kit.

Household Batteries: Place them in a zipper-lock style bag on top of (**not inside**) your **recyclables** collection cart. Cover/tape the terminals. No automotive or liquid lithium-ion batteries are allowed.

Extra Cardboard: Flatten, cut into pieces no larger than two feet by three feet, and stack next to your **recyclables** cart.
