THE ACI MULTI-FAMILY TENANT ON-CALL CLEAN UP PROGRAM

Take Advantage of an On-Call Clean up



All multi-family residential customers receive one (1) on-call clean up day per household/unit per year at no additional charge. For additional information, scan the QR code or visit AlamedaCountyIndustries.com/alameda/cleanup

AN ACI MULTI-FAMILY ON-CALL CLEAN UP INCLUDES:

Reusable Items - Clean, undamaged reusable items. Must be marked "Reuse" and set apart from clean up items. Scan the QR code for a downloadable sign.

Clean Up Items - Up to three cubic yards (3' x 3' x 9') of materials (including reusable items). See photo above for an example of a set out. Trash and recyclables must be contained (bagged, boxed, or bundled). Please bundle yard trimmings and clean wood (up to 6 inches in diameter and no longer than 4 feet). Bag small/loose trimmings. **Pressure treated wood is not accepted and is considered hazardous waste. Visit resource.stopwaste.org (see right) for more info.**

Large Bulky Items - Up to three (3) large bulky items such as appliances, mattresses, and furniture (up to 150 lbs. each). One item can be electronic waste.

PLEASE NOTE: Fees will be charged for exceeding the volume or the acceptable item limits listed. Extra clean ups can be arranged for a fee. Visit our website AlamedaCountyIndustries.com/alameda/cleanup or contact us for rates.

Properly Manage Household Hazardous Waste



Hazardous waste does NOT belong in any ACI collection cart or bin. Before disposal, check the label. If it's marked **Danger, Warning, Poisonous, Toxic, or Flammable**, it's hazardous and requires special handling. Many hazardous items can be taken to Alameda County's local HHW collection facility. Take advantage of this free drop-off program. Visit StopWaste.org/hhw for location, hours, and more info.

Keep Our Workers Safe

Hazardous waste does **NOT** belong in any ACI collection cart or bin.



NO SHARPS

"Sharps" is a medical term for devices with sharp points or edges that can puncture or cut skin such as needles, syringes, lancets, auto injectors (such as EpiPens), and infusion sets.



BATTERIES DON'T BELONG

Batteries that are not handled properly can start fires, endangering our employees and damaging vehicles and equipment.
